- Knowledge of work operations in white drug manufacturing rooms.
- Analytical capacity, teamwork, initiative, organization and prioritization of tasks.

Support to the Head of the Quality Unit in the activities of:

- Monitoring of ISO 9001 and expanding the certification scope to other Platforms of scientific and technical services.
- Monitoring of the Standards of Correct Manufacture of Medicines of Advanced Therapy (NCF-MTA) in the White Room. Quality assurance in the production of batches of manufactured medicines.
- Monitoring of the UNE 166002 to the Transfer and Innovation Unit.
- Monitoring of good clinical practices at CIM Sant-Pau and extension of the certification scope in the Phase I/II Clinical Trials Unit of Medical Oncology.
- Internal regulatory compliance audits (ISO 9001 and UNE 166002 areas).

- Internal audits of clinical trials of CIM Sant Pau (BPC) and phases of manufacture / quality control of advanced therapy drugs, as an independent Quality Unit.
- Participation in external regulatory compliance audits applicable to the different Management Systems certified /accredited in the IR-HSCSP.
- Implementation of the process-based management model.
- Advice on compliance with regulations.
