The Institute

The **Fundació Institut de Recerca de l'Hospital de la Santa Creu i Sant Pau** is a scientific foundation whose mission is to improve the health and quality of life of the population, through the production and dissemination of scientific knowledge, the training of researchers at an international level and the promotion of innovation and health through the incorporation of medical advances in clinical practice and health policies. Created in 1992, in 2003 it was attached to the Autonomous University of Barcelona (UAB) and since 2011 it has been part of the CERCA Program of the Generalitat de Catalunya.

For the Foundation, it is a priority to ensure that the recruitment of the most suitable candidate to fill a job is done through an open, transparent and merit-based (OTM-R) selection process. Following these guidelines will promote the mobility of staff, the exchange of knowledge and, ultimately, the increase in the quality of teaching and research. About the Unit / Group:

The main lines of research at the Group are: The identification of new biomarkers of atherothrombosis and ischemic heart disease with potential use in diagnostic and prognostic research is based on cell culture studies, animal models of cardiovascular disease, and human samples from patients with coronary heart disease risk factors.
