The institution

The Research Institute Foundation of the Hospital de la Santa Creu i Sant Pau a scientific foundation whose mission is to improve the health and quality of life of the population, through the production and dissemination of scientific knowledge, the training of researchers at an international level and the promotion of innovation and health by incorporating the medical advances in clinical practice and health policies. Created in 1992, in 2003 it was attached to the Autonomous University of Barcelona (UAB) and since 2011 it has been part of the CERCA Program of the Generalitat of Catalonia.

For the Foundation, it is a priority to ensure that the most suitable candidate to fill a job is hired through an open, transparent and merit-based selection process (OTM-R). Following these guidelines will enhance the mobility of staff, the exchange of knowledge and, ultimately, the increase in the quality of teaching and research. Faithful to the commitment to the human resources strategy of the European Union, our institution's personnel selection and hiring procedures are governed by a set of basic principles that guarantee equal access to employment for all. Therefore, the constitutional principles of equality, merit and capacity are followed, respecting in any case the current national and international regulations in this area, specifically the European Charter for Researchers and the Code of Conduct for the recruitment of researchers (C&C). The main lines of research of the Oncological Hematology and Transplantation Group are:

- Study of the prognostic value of clinical and biological parameters in hematological malignancies.

- Design of new modalities of hematopoietic stem cell transplantation and cell treatments.
