

INTERNAL / EXTERNAL CALL

The Institution

The **Research Institute Foundation of the Hospital de la Santa Creu and Sant Pau** is a scientific foundation whose mission is to improve the health and quality of life of the population, through the production and dissemination of scientific knowledge, the training of researchers at an international level and the promotion of innovation and health by incorporating the medical advances in clinical practice and health policies. Created in 1992, in 2003 it was attached to the Autonomous University of Barcelona (UAB) and since 2011 it has been part of the CERCA Program of the Generalitat of Catalonia.

For the Foundation, it is a priority to ensure that the most suitable candidate to fill a job is hired through an open, transparent and merit-based selection process (OTM-R). Following these guidelines will enhance the mobility of staff, the exchange of knowledge and, ultimately, the increase in the quality of teaching and research. Faithful to the commitment to the human resources strategy of the European Union, our institution's personnel selection and hiring procedures are governed by a set of basic principles that guarantee equal access to employment for all. Therefore, the constitutional principles of equality, merit and capacity are followed, respecting in any case the current national and international regulations in this area, specifically the European Charter for Researchers and the Code of Conduct for the recruitment of researchers (C&C). About the Unit / Group:

- Application of imaging techniques in the intraoperative study of perforators with the aim of improving the design of pendants, evaluating the suitability and feasibility of perfusion, avoiding secondary postoperative complications and vascular complications.
- Anatomical studies of the variability of perforators in the following regions: internal mammary artery, inferior epigastric system, and internal superficial circumflex system.

- Study of the perioperative and postoperative factors that influence the viability of microsurgical free pendants.
- Search by indocyanine green angiography for the concept of post-dissectional post-vascular balance of the perforator pendant.
- Investigation by means of indocyanine green angiography of the relationship between the different anatomical patterns of the lymphatic vessels of the upper extremity and their predisposition to develop lymphedema in patients affected by breast cancer.
- Feasibility of research in animal models of the main surgical and non-surgical techniques currently available for the treatment of secondary lymphatic insufficiency: autologous fat transplantation, autologous bone marrow stem cell transplantation, free vascularized lymphatic-venous anastomosis pendant autologous lymph node.
