The Institute

The **Santa Creu i Sant Pau Hospital Research Institute Foundation** is a scientific foundation which mission is to improve health and quality of life of the population, through the production and dissemination of scientific knowledge, training of researchers to an international standard, and promoting health innovation and the incorporation of medical advances in clinical practice and healthcare policies. Created in 1992, the institute was attached to the Autonomous University of Barcelona (UAB) in 2003, and since 2011 it is part of the Government of Catalonia's CERCA Programme.

For the Foundation, it is a priority to ensure that the most suitable candidate is hired to fill a job through an open, transparent and merit-based selection process (OTM-R). Following these guidelines, staff mobility, knowledge exchange and, ultimately, the increase in the quality of teaching and research will be enhanced. Faithful to our commitment to the European Union's human resources strategy, our institution's personnel selection and recruitment procedures are governed by a set of basic principles that guarantee equal access to employability for all. Therefore, the constitutional principles of equality, merit and ability are followed, respecting in all cases the national and international regulations in force in this area, specifically the European Charter for Researchers and the Code of Conduct for the Recruitment of Researchers (C&C). Essential requirements

- Excellent oral and written knowledge of both official languages in Catalonia, Catalan (c-level) and Spanish; as well as good command (full professional proficiency) of English.
- Advanced knowledge of office tools (excel, word, power point, etc).

- Master or postgraduate studies in Science Communication, Digital Communications o Science Education.
- Experience in developing and designing public engagement and science education activities.
- Strong communication, writing and presentation skills.
- Compelling writer and editor with content curation skills and ability to produce engaging and innovative content.



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- Good planning and organisational skills. Capability to work independently. Proactive, flexible, open-minded person used to work in multidisciplinary and multicultural environments.
- Team player with ability to navigate a highly complex organisational structure and operational processes.
- Creative strategic thinker who can both shape projects, drive delivery and personally execute.
- Ability to build collaborative relationships with diverse stakeholders and to work at differing level, from briefing senior leaders to speak to general public and schools.
- High standard of quality in all communications outputs.
- Proficiency in both long-term strategic planning and impromptu on-deadline performance.
- Good knowledge of digital media, experience with CMS Systems (e.g. Wordpress, Drupal), marketing and emailing platforms (e.g. Mailchimp), social media management platforms (e.g. Hootsuite), graphic design tools (e.g. Adobe Creative Suite, Canva), video editing, and metrics (e.g. Google Analytics).

Functions

The main responsibilities (although not exclusive) for this position are as follow:

- Coordinate and develop existing programmes and outreach activities.
- Contribute, generate and evaluate new projects and ideas to engage with our stakeholders.
- Content production to promote our activities and campaigns, such as news, texts for website, brochures, social media posts, mailings and digital, audio-visual or multimedia content.
- Contributing to the preparation of grant proposals for communications and public engagement activities and actions at national and international level.
- Engaging in and supporting other activities of the Communications and Stakeholder Relations team.

This position requires flexibility and may require some weekend work or nonstandard working hours dedication, due to the nature of general public activities (open days, science talks, etc).

PERMANENCE COMMITMENT: Selected persons who will hold the summoned or vacant position, will not be able to apply for a new call until 1-year period has expired. The vacant summoned, and the ones that derive from it (intern movements), will be successively covered on the same proceeding among the submitted candidates to each particular call, regardless of whether this entails coverage of places in turns other than the call.
