



The Institution

The Santa Creu i Sant Pau Hospital Research Institute Foundation was created on June 4, 1992, it is a scientific foundation whose mission is to promote basic, clinical, epidemiological and health service research in the field of health sciences and biomedicine, with the aim of contributing to the improvement of people's health and quality of life, through the production and dissemination of scientific knowledge, the training of researchers at international level, the generation of health innovations, the application of advances in healthcare practice and health policies.

Located on the Sant Pau Campus, it is a biomedical research center of excellence attached to the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona (UAB) since 2009, and since 2011 it has been a center of the CERCA system in Catalonia.

The Institute is made up of its own and seconded staff, who carry out their research in multidisciplinary basic and clinical research groups, coming from twinned entities located on the Sant Pau campus and its surroundings. This means that it has also been recognized since 2011 as a high-level health research center aimed at developing new techniques and processes through health innovation.

The Research Institute is one of the most active Catalan centers in the production of research work, especially in terms of translational research and the integration of new discoveries into healthcare practice.

In November 2018, the Institute signed its adherence to the Code of Conduct for CERCA Centres.

In 2020, the Institute signed the Letter of Commitment for gender equality in Research which was supported by 19 Catalan research and health centers and was read during the "Cumbre para el Avance y el Liderazgo de las Women in Health Sciences", on October 22, 2019 in Girona.

PERMANENCE COMMITMENT: Selected persons who will hold the summoned or vacant position, will not be able to apply for a new call until 1-year period has expired. The vacant summoned, and the ones that derive from it (intern movements), will be successively covered on the same proceeding among the submitted candidates to each particular call, regardless of whether this entails coverage of places in turns other than the call.
